

## J University Jr. Refund Policy

It is our hope that you children will enjoy the extra curricular courses that they attend.

1. All classes and lessons must be paid in full before each J University Jr. session
2. Classes dropped 7 days prior to the first scheduled class - 100% refund less \$25 processing fee
3. Classes dropped after the first class - 50% refund less \$25 processing fee
4. Thereafter - no refund

The JCC reserves the right to cancel a class due to low enrollment. \$25 service fee assessed for insufficient funds.

## J University Jr. Information

- Full-year offerings are classes where children develop skills that they continue to build upon. These classes run the entire school year (excluding summer) and late registrations are accepted.
- Full payment is due upon registration.
- Full-year classes run through May 25, 2012
- Current research on brain development points out the dramatic effects of reading, art, and using movement/dancing at an early age. The brain is the ultimate "use it or lose it machine." Full-year classes were designed to stimulate the young child's mind.
- These classes are very popular. Registration is on a first come, first served basis.
- We adhere to strict maximum in each class. When an individual class fills up, we will make every effort to open another section, if possible.
- You do not have to be a JCC member to participate in these classes. Non-member rates are listed for each class.

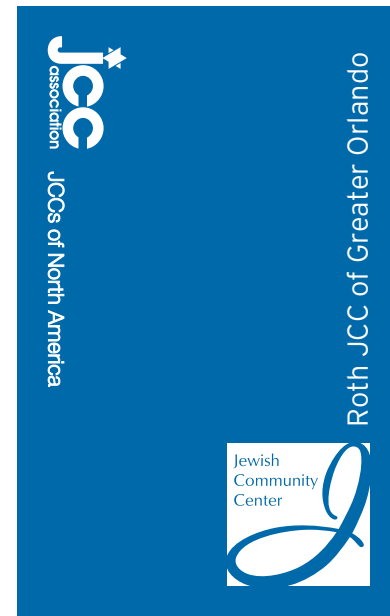
